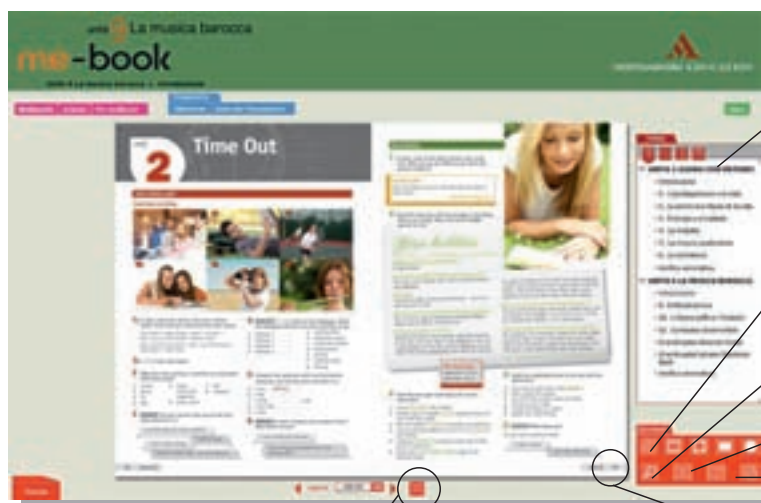

LISTENING

True/False/Not mentioned activities

- In True/False/Not mentioned exercises, you should read the statements **BEFORE** you listen to get an idea of what you are listening for.
- Be careful. The words in the statements are not always exactly the same in the listening text. They often express the same idea but in a different way.
- Put **Not mentioned** if you do not hear the information when you listen to the text.

SPEAKING

Reporting past events

- Before doing a speaking exam where you have to report past events, check that you know as many regular and irregular past forms as possible.
- Learn and use words or expressions of time (yesterday, then, two weeks ago ...) to explain when things happened.
- Use fillers like *Well, Hmm* or *Let me think* to give you time to think of what you want to say next.
- Use basic question words like *Who? What? When? Where? How? Why?* to help you think of more things to say.
